WHO ARE THE ONES WE HELP?







Single mothers & elderly

Those who can't pay rent and food

Those who lost their job or qualify for zakat

Common scenarios:

Single mom taking care of children and/or elderly.

Family about to get evicted from their home.

Breadwinner lost his job and tens of thousands in debt.

Single mom's job hours cut, minimum wage.

Refugee not eligible for stimiulus payments.

Elderly lost all wealth and no family to help support.

Youth has to pay full tuition but is not eligible for stimulus payments or childcare payments. Has job to cover fees. And the family is eligible for zakat.

Are eligible to receive zakat



Live in Greater Danbury, Connecticut



Struggle to pay for groceries



Struggle to pay their rent, mortgage and/or utility bills



Have run out of unemployment insurance and can't find a job right now



Are not making enough to make ends meet






